Basic Functions:

Under the general supervision of the special education administrator and the daily supervision of the site administrator, provides instruction and services for those pupils whose needs have been identified in a written individualized education program developed by the school appraisal team or the educational assessment service and who are assigned to regular classroom teachers for a majority of school day, and performs other duties as related to the implementation of PL 94-142 and AB1250.

Representative Duties:

- 1. Assist the School Appraisal Team in decisions regarding placement and in the development of individualized Education Plans for students considered for the Resource Specialist Program.
- 2. Provide direct instructional service to handicapped children on a pullout basis and provide consultant service to their regular class teachers; provide overall direction and supervision of the Resource Specialist Instructional Assistant.
- 3. Conduct educational assessments to determine pupil qualification for Resource Specialist Program and to maintain progress of students assigned to the program.
- 4. Participate in staff development activities as provided by the Auxiliary Education Department and the Riverside county Consortium.
- 5. Train and provide work direction and guidance to assigned personnel; organize and conduct in-services for parents or staff, as directed.
- 6. Arrange and conduct parent conferences assuring parent awareness of pupil progress, enlisting parent cooperation and involvement in program planning and development. Obtain authorization for special services as needed.
- 7. Consult with other professionals as needed in the development and implementation of the Individualized Educational Program.
- 8. Maintain all records as required relating to pupil attendance, program plans, and pupil progress.
- 9. Maintain compliance and complete Individual Education Plan's within state and federal timelines.
- 10. Participate in continuous evaluation and upgrading of the schools' Special Education Program.
- 11. Perform other duties as related to the implementation of PL 94-142 and AB1250.
