Do I have to enroll in medical, dental and vision benefits?	Yes, SISC requires all employees who work 90% or more of the full-time equivalent to be enrolled in a medical plan through DSUSD. However, you may decline if you provide proof of Medi-Cal, Tricare, Medicare Parts A&B, or Covered CA. Again, proof is required and other conditions may apply.

What if I am changing medical plans and am on medication now that is expiring or has no refills?	PSUSD Certificated, Management & Confidential employees <u>Kaiser and Anthem Blue Cross Members</u> : We strongly recommend that you refill your medications as close to 9/30/23 as possible so that you have plenty for October. Also, check to see if you need your current Provider to give you more refills.
