Basic Functions:

The Project Teacher's primary function is to assist the principal and staff with coordination of instructional support materials, and strategies, special projects, student assessment data collection, and staff development activities.

- 5. Assists in planning, organizing, and implementing with and through faculty, a staff development program to promote effective teaching and learning.
- 6. Serves as principal's designee as needed.
- 7. Performs other related duties as assigned by the principal.
